Bible Passage: Jesus Notices a Widow Giving (Mark 12:41-44)

One day Jesus sat down near where the people came to give their money to the Temple. He saw rich people come by and put in lots of money. Then he saw a poor old woman whose husband had died come by to put in her money. All she had was two little coins. But even though those coins were all she had, she gave them both to the Temple. Jesus told his disciples that the woman had given much more than the rich people, because she had given all she had.
