BIBLE PASSAGE: God Sends Quail and Manna – Exodus 16:1-26

FAITH WORD: COURAGE



The Israelites had reached a place called the Desert of Sin. They were tired and hungry, and they started complaining. They told Moses and Aaron that they had plenty of food to eat in Egypt, and now they were afraid they were going to die in the desert! They were wishing they had stayed in Egypt, even though they had been slaves there!

But do you know what God did? He made it rain bread from heaven every morning, and then he sent these birds called quail every evening. But he sent only enough for one day at a time, so the Israelites had to trust God every single day to provide their food for them. And God did it!

Don't you think God will provide what you need every day, too?



Bible Point: God gives us what we need.

Key Verse: "You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows." (Psalm 23:5)



Grocery Store Trip

Take your child to the grocery store and ask him or her to remember how the Israelites felt when they were very hungry in the desert. Explain that some people in your neighborhood are very hungry, too, because they don't have enough food to eat. Remind your child that God provided food for the Israelites. When we give food to those who need it, we're showing God's love to others. Have your child choose a favorite nonperishable food. Then donate that item to a local food bank or shelter, letting your child experience firsthand the joy of giving.

- What ways can you help God give?

Overflowing Cup

Place a cup on a pie tin in the center of the table and fill the cup two-thirds full of water. Set a bag of marbles on the table. As family members sit around the table, have each person tell something that God provides for your family and drop a marble into the cup. Keep adding marbles until the water flows over the top of the cup.

Then have the person who added the marble that caused the overflow lead the family in thanking God for providing for their needs.
