BIBLE PASSAGE: God Gives the Ten Commandments (Part 2) Exodus 19:16-20:21

The last six commandments God gave Moses instructed the Israelites how to respect others. The Israelites must have needed to know these things, since God made a pretty big deal out of telling Moses what they were. We need to know them, too!

So, to refresh your memory, here they are—don't murder, don't commit adultery, don't steal, don't lie, honor your father and mother, and don't covet what your neighbor has. Seems like there is a lot involved in respecting others, but if you follow God's commandments, guess what! You'll be respecting others!

Bible Point: God tells us how to respect others.

Key Verse: "Do not murder, do not commit adultery, do not steal, do not give false testimony, honor your father and mother,' and 'love your neighbor as yourself'" (Matthew 19:18-19).

Day of Respect

Have each family member take a slip of paper and write down one way he or she would like to be shown respect by other family members. Place all the slips of paper in a bag. Then each morning at breakfast, have one family member pull out one slip of paper. The rest of the family must do everything they can to show respect to the person named in the way that person specified. Each day a different family member's paper will be drawn, and it will be his or her Day of Respect!

Have your child practice ways of treating others kindly. Talk with your child about nice things he or she could do for a neighbor, such as making a card or cookies or planting a flower. Help your child with the project and go with your child as he or she visits the neighbor.

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Ten Commandment Book
