

Peace Kids At Home Lesson

for January 23, 2022 (ages 3-6th grade)

BIBLE PASSAGE: Jesus Teaches in the Synagogue Luke 4:14-21

People were amazed at Jesus' teaching. They praised Jesus as he traveled from town to town. One day, Jesus went to his hometown of Nazareth. It was the Sabbath, so he went to the synagogue. When the people asked Jesus to read Scripture, he was happy to read. He read what Isaiah said about the coming Messiah: That God's Spirit would choose him to preach good news to the poor, to set prisoners free, to make the blind see, to release slaves, and to tell everyone about God's love. When Jesus sat down, everyone stared at him. He told them that the prophet had written about him. Jesus was the Savior the people had been waiting for.

Bible Point: Jesus came for all people.

Key Verse: "For the Son of Man came to seek and to save what was lost" (Luke 19:10)



Praying for the Lost

Ask your parents to set aside a time you, as a family, can gather and have a prayer time for lost people. Start the time with a short Bible study. Before you gather, ask your mom or dad to help you find a verse in the Bible that talks about telling others about Jesus. When your family gathers, read the verse together. Make a list of the people you go to school with, the people your parents work with, and the people who live in your neighborhood who need to know about Jesus. Have each family member take a name, and take turns praying aloud for that person. Ask God to help you other that Jesus loves us? tell those people about Jesus.

Good News Notes

Write every family member's name on a piece of paper and put it in a hat. Take turns choosing names. Make sure no one chooses his or her own name. Throughout the week, each person can design several creative notes to remind the person whose name he or she drew that Jesus came for that person. For example, Mom could put a note in her child's lunchbox. Dad could put a note on Mom's pillow. A child could put a note in Dad's briefcase. Be clever and creative. Surprise one another with the good news of Jesus' love.
